A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Safety – Emergency Medical Services – Motorcycle Response Unit**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a county or municipality to establish, by local law, an
4 emergency medical response unit that travels by motorcycle to assist with
5 emergencies within the boundaries of the county or municipality; providing that the
6 local law shall require a member of a certain unit to possess certain licenses or
7 certifications; requiring the State Emergency Medical Services Board to establish
8 policies and procedures for the operation of a certain unit; defining a certain term;
9 and generally relating to emergency medical services.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Public Safety**

18 **7–404.**

19 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, “EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDER” HAS**
20 **THE MEANING STATED IN § 13–516 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.**

21 **(B) (1) A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY MAY ESTABLISH, BY LOCAL LAW, AN**
22 **EMERGENCY MEDICAL RESPONSE UNIT THAT TRAVELS BY MOTORCYCLE TO ASSIST**
23 **WITH EMERGENCIES WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(2) THE LOCAL LAW SHALL REQUIRE A MEMBER OF THE UNIT TO BE**
2 **LICENSED OR CERTIFIED AS AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDER BY THE**
3 **STATE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES BOARD.**

4 **(C) THE STATE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES BOARD SHALL**
5 **ESTABLISH POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE OPERATION OF AN EMERGENCY**
6 **MEDICAL RESPONSE UNIT THAT TRAVELS BY MOTORCYCLE.**

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2018.
