

- 4 FOR the purpose of establishing a country club off-sale permit in Montgomery County; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Montgomery County to issue 5 6 the permit to a holder of a country club license; authorizing a holder of the permit to 7 sell wine by the bottle for off-premises consumption only at certain tasting events, 8 to certain individuals, and during certain hours and days; requiring a permit holder 9 to notify the Board in writing a certain number of days before each tasting event; 10 authorizing the Board to set a certain permit fee; and generally relating to sales of 11 alcoholic beverages in Montgomery County.
