SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 Article Education
- 17 7-203.1.

18 (a) (1) **(I)** For fiscal years 2003 and 2004, the Department shall distribute 19 grants to qualified distressed counties, as defined in § 1–101 of the Economic Development

3 [(2)] (II) For fiscal year 2005 and each subsequent fiscal year, the 4 Department shall distribute grants to each county for the administration of the Preliminary 5 Scholastic Aptitude Test to 10th grade students.

6 [(b)] (2) Subject to the availability of funding in the State budget, the amount of 7 each county's grant shall be in an amount sufficient for the administration of the test to all 8 10th grade students in the county.

IN THIS SUBSECTION, "STUDENT" MEANS A STUDENT WHO IS 9 **(B)** (1) ENROLLED IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL IN THE STATE AND IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE 10 MARYLAND CHILDREN'S HEALTH PROGRAM UNDER TITLE 15, SUBTITLE 3 OF THE 11 12HEALTH - GENERAL ARTICLE FREE OR REDUCED PRICED MEALS OR AN ALTERNATIVE STANDARD DEVELOPED BY THE STATE BOARD FOR SCHOOLS IN 13COUNTIES THAT PARTICIPATE IN THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF 14 AGRICULTURE COMMUNITY ELIGIBILITY PROVISION. 15

26(II)A COUNTY BOARD IS NOT REQUIRED TO PAY FOR MORE27THAN ONE EXAM PER SCHOOL YEAR PER STUDENT.

(4) ON APPLICATION BY A COUNTY BOARD TO THE STATE BOARD,
THE STATE SHALL PROVIDE A GRANT TO THE COUNTY BOARD IN AN AMOUNT
NECESSARY TO REIMBURSE A COUNTY BOARD FOR PAYMENTS MADE UNDER
PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

32 (5) THE STATE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT
 33 THIS SUBSECTION, INCLUDING PROCEDURES FOR SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION
 34 FOR REIMBURSEMENT.
