- 4 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.
- 5 (C) BEFORE THE COUNTY TRANSFERS AN ASSET OF THE COUNTY THAT IS
 6 LOCATED IN A MUNICIPALITY AS PART OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF A MAGNETIC
 7 LEVITATION TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM THAT PASSES THROUGH THE COUNTY, THE
 8 COUNTY SHALL NEGOTIATE A WRITTEN AGREEMENT WITH THE MUNICIPALITY
 9 CONCERNING:
- 10 (1) THE APPROVAL BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE TRANSFER; AND
- 11 (2) THE SHARING WITH THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANY FINANCIAL 12 REMUNERATION THE COUNTY RECEIVES UNDER THE TRANSFER.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2018.
