BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 11 12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Education** 13 9.5-401.14 15 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated. "Child" means an individual under the age of 16 years. 16 (b) "CHILD CARE" MEANS THE CARE OR SUPERVISION OF A CHILD 17 WHEN THE CHILD'S PARENT HAS GIVEN THE CHILD'S CARE OVER TO ANOTHER 18 INDIVIDUAL FOR SOME PORTION OF A 24-HOUR DAY AS A SUPPLEMENT TO THE 19 20 PARENT'S PRIMARY CARE OF THE CHILD.

- 1 (I) A BEFORE-SCHOOL OR AFTER-SCHOOL ACTIVITY 2 CONDUCTED OR SPONSORED BY A PUBLIC SCHOOL OR A NONPUBLIC SCHOOL THAT 3 IS APPROVED OR EXEMPT FROM APPROVAL BY THE DEPARTMENT;
- 4 (II) SCOUTING ACTIVITIES, ACTIVITIES PROVIDED BY A SPORTS
 5 BUSINESS, OR YOUTH CLUB ACTIVITIES, IF CUSTODIAL SUPERVISION IS NOT THE
 6 PRIMARY PURPOSE OF THE ACTIVITIES BEING PROVIDED;
- 7 (III) SCHOOL-AGE RECREATIONAL OR SUPPLEMENTARY
 8 EDUCATION PROGRAMS OPERATED BY A LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION AND
 9 PARKS, A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, OR A PUBLIC SCHOOL OR A NONPUBLIC

 THE SPONSOR WHILE THE PARENTS ARE ON THE SAME PREMISES AS THE SERVICES
 TO THE CHILDREN AND ARE IMMEDIATELY AVAILABLE TO THE CHILDREN; OR

- [(c)] (D) (1) "Child care center" means an agency, institution, or establishment that, for part or all of a day, or on a 24-hour basis on a regular schedule, and at least twice a week, offers or provides child care to children who do not have the same parentage except as otherwise provided for in law or regulation.
- 24 (2) "Child care center" shall include a nonpublic nursery school in which 25 an instructional program is offered or provided for children who are under the age of 5 26 years.
- 27 (3) "Child care center" does not include:
- 28 (i) A nonpublic kindergarten in which an instructional program is offered or provided for children who are at least 5 years old;
- 30 (ii) A nonpublic elementary school in which an instructional 31 program is offered or provided for children who are in grades 1 through 8;
- 32 (iii) A child care home, a child care institution, or other child care 33 facility that offers or provides a residential placement for a child and is established, 34 licensed, or registered under this title, Title 9 of the Human Services Article, or Title 10 of 35 the Health General Article; or

- 1 (iv) A family child care home or large family child care home that is 2 required to be registered or is registered under this title.
- 3 **[**(d)**] (E)** "Letter of compliance" means a letter issued by the Department to a religious organization that meets the requirements under § 9.5–404 of this subtitle.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 6 $\,$ 1, 2018.
