# Baltimore City – Alcoholic Beverages – Continuing Care Retirement Community License

FOR the purpose of establishing a continuing care retirement community license in 4 Baltimore City; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue the license  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 for use by a continuing care retirement community that is located in a certain area 7 of the City and that has obtained a certain certificate of registration; specifying that 8 the license authorizes the holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor to a community 9 resident or the guest of a resident for on-premises consumption; allowing a resident 10 or the guest of a resident under certain circumstances to consume beer, wine, or 11 liquor not purchased from the community; establishing certain license fees; and 12 generally relating to a continuing care retirement community license in Baltimore 13City.

(2) 1 THE CONTINUING CARE RETIREMENT COMMUNITY:  $\mathbf{2}$ **(I)** IS OPERATED BY A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION FOR 3 **INDIVIDUALS AT LEAST 60 YEARS OLD; (II)** HAS BEEN INCORPORATED FOR A LEAST 1 YEAR; AND 4  $\mathbf{5}$ (III) PREPARES SERVES MEALS AND DURING REGULAR 6 OPERATING HOURS TO RESIDENTS AND THEIR GUESTS. 7 **(E)** (1) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$550. (2) IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE, THE LICENSE HOLDER 8 9 SHALL PAY ANNUALLY: 10 \$500, **(I)** IF THE LICENSE HOLDER PROVIDES LIVE 11 ENTERTAINMENT; AND **\$200,** IF THE LICENSE HOLDER PROVIDES OUTDOOR TABLE 12**(II)** 13SERVICE. 14SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 151, 2018.
