BY repealing Article – Criminal Law Section 10–501 Annotated Code of Maryland (2012 Replacement Volume and 2017 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Criminal Law [10-501. A person may not commit adultery. (a) (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction shall be fined \$10.1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2018.
