- 3 FOR the purpose of increasing the limit on the maximum salary that the Board of Public
- Works may set for a clerk of a circuit court; providing for the application of this Act;

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 (a) The clerk of each circuit court shall receive an annual salary of not more than
- 16 [\$114,500] **\$124,500** as set by the Board of Public Works on the basis of the relative volume
- 17 of business and receipts in the clerk's office.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35
- 19 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary
- 20 or compensation of the clerk of a circuit court while serving in a term of office beginning
- 21 before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or
- 22 compensation of the clerk of a circuit court shall take effect at the beginning of the next
- 23 following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected
- 24 after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.



SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2018.
