1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Dorchester County – Hurlock – Alcoholic Beverages – Place-of-Worship or**
3 **School Distance Restrictions**

4 FOR the purpose of exempting the Town of Hurlock from a prohibition against issuing a
5 certain alcoholic beverages license for an establishment that is within a certain
6 distance from a place of worship or a public or nonpublic school in Dorchester County;
7 and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Dorchester County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

2 This title applies only in Dorchester County.

3 19-1601.

4 (a) (1) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the Board may not
5 issue a new license for an establishment that is within 300 feet in a direct line of a place of
6 worship or a public or nonpublic kindergarten, elementary, or secondary school.

7 (2) The distance from the establishment to the place of worship or the
8 public or nonpublic kindergarten, elementary, or secondary school is to be measured from
9 the establishment in a direct line to the nearest point of the main building of the place of
10 worship or school.

11 (b) The prohibition against issuing a license in subsection (a) of this section does
12 not apply to the issuance of:

13 (1) a license for a premises that was licensed on October 1, 1996;

14 (2) a Class B (on-sale) beer, wine, and liquor license for a premises in
15 Cambridge [or], Secretary, **OR HURLOCK**; or

16 (3) a temporary license.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
18 1, 2018.
