A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Motor Vehicle Registration - Exception for Golf Carts - Town of Vienna

3 FOR the purpose of creating an exception from motor vehicle registration requirements 4 under certain circumstances for golf carts in the Town of Vienna; providing that a 5 person who operates a golf cart on a highway in the Town of Vienna may operate the 6 golf cart only on certain roads at certain times and only if the golf cart is equipped 7 with certain lighting devices; requiring a person who operates a golf cart on a 8 highway in the Town of Vienna to keep as far to the right of the roadway as feasible 9 and possess a valid driver's license; authorizing the State Highway Administration, in consultation with the appropriate local authority, to develop locations where a 10 11 person operating a golf cart may cross certain highways; making certain conforming 12 changes; and generally relating to an exception to motor vehicle registration 13 requirements for golf carts in the Town of Vienna.

- 24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 1 13-402.2 Except as otherwise provided in this section or elsewhere in the 3 Maryland Vehicle Law, each motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, and pole trailer driven on a highway shall be registered under this subtitle. 4 5 (c) Registration under this subtitle is not required for: 6 (1) A vehicle that is driven on a highway: 7 (i) In conformity with the provisions of this title relating to 8 manufacturers, transporters, dealers, secured parties, owners or operators of special mobile 9 equipment, or nonresidents; or 10 (ii) Under temporary registration card issued the 11 Administration; 12 (2)A vehicle owned and used by the United States, unless an authorized 13 officer or employee of the United States requests registration of the vehicle; 14 (3)A farm tractor or any farm equipment; 15 (4) A vehicle the front or rear wheels of which are lifted from the highway; 16 A towed vehicle that is attached to the towing vehicle by a tow bar and 17 for which no driver is necessary;
- 18 (6) A vehicle owned by and in the possession of a licensed dealer for purpose 19 of sale;
- 20 (7) A vehicle owned by a new resident of this State during the first 60 days of residency provided the vehicle displays valid registration issued by the jurisdiction of the resident's former domicile;
- 23 (8) New vehicles being operated as part of a shuttle, as defined in § 13–626 of this title, while following a registered vehicle displaying a shuttle permit issued by the 25 Administration;
- 26 (9) A vehicle operated in connection with maritime commerce exclusively within any terminal owned or leased by the Maryland Port Administration;
- 28 (10) A snowmobile that is operated on highways and roadways as prescribed 29 by § 25–102(a)(14) of this article;
- 30 (11) A golf cart that is operated on a highway on Smith Island, provided that 31 the golf cart is equipped with lighting devices as required by the Administration if it is 32 operated on a highway between dusk and dawn;

- [(b)] (C) The State Highway Administration, in consultation with [the City of Crisfield] THE APPROPRIATE LOCAL AUTHORITY, may designate [a location] LOCATIONS in the City of Crisfield OR THE TOWN OF VIENNA where a person operating a golf cart may cross, at a right angle, a highway that is designated or maintained as a part or an extension of the State or federal highway system.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2018.
