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## State Personnel - Grievance Procedures - Exclusive Representatives

- 3 FOR the purpose of expanding the application of certain provisions of law governing 4 grievance procedures for certain employees in the State Personnel Management 5 System to include certain exclusive representatives; authorizing certain exclusive 6 representatives to present certain grievances free from coercion, discrimination, 7 interference, reprisal, or restraint; requiring a grievant to complete certain forms in 8 a certain manner for a certain purpose; applying a certain definition of "grievance" 9 to a certain requirement that the Department of Transportation adopt certain 10 regulations relating to employee grievance procedures; altering a certain definition; defining a certain term; making a conforming change; and generally relating to 11 12 grievance procedures and exclusive representatives of State employees.


