Article - Education 1 2 3-701.3 (a) (1) The Howard County Board consists of: 4 (i) Seven elected members; and One student member. 5 (ii) 6 (2) The seven elected members shall be elected as follows: 7 Five members, each of whom resides in a different one of the five councilmanic districts in the county; and 8 9 (ii) Two members who may reside anywhere in the county. 10 3-702.At its first meeting in December, the county board shall elect a [chairman] CHAIR 11 12from among its members. 13 3-703.14 The [chairman] CHAIR of the county board is entitled to receive [\$17,000] \$18,000 annually as compensation and the other elected members are entitled to receive 15 16 [\$15,000] **\$16,000** each annually as compensation. 17 After submitting vouchers under the rules and regulations adopted by the county board, the [chairman] CHAIR and the other elected members are entitled to receive 18 19 reimbursement for travel and other expenses as provided in the Howard County budget. 20 The employer's share for State retirement and pension contributions made on 21behalf of the [chairman] CHAIR and other elected board members may not be considered 22compensation for the purpose of calculating compensation under subsection (a) of this 23section. 24(d) (1)The [chairman] CHAIR and other elected board members may 25participate in health insurance and other benefit programs sponsored by the board. 26 (2)An elected board member's participation in a benefit program 27 sponsored by the board under this subsection may not be considered compensation for the

29 (e) (1) (i) A student member who completes a full term on the board shall 30 be entitled to a scholarship of \$5,000 to be applied to the student's higher education costs.

7 8 9	(2) On the submission of expense vouchers, the student member is entitled to reimbursement for travel and other expenses incurred in the performance of official duties for the county board.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the chair and members of the Howard County Board of Education while serving in a term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the chair and members of the Howard County Board of Education shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term.
