A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Howard County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class C BWL License**

3 **Ho. Co. 21–18**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class C beer, wine, and liquor 7–day license in Howard
5 County; specifying that the license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine,
6 and liquor at retail at the place described in the license for on–premises
7 consumption; providing for an annual license fee; and generally relating to alcoholic
8 beverages licenses in Howard County.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

22 23–102.

23 This title applies only in Howard County.

2 **(A) THERE IS A CLASS C BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR 7-DAY LICENSE.**

3 **(B) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO SELL BEER, WINE,**
4 **AND LIQUOR AT RETAIL AT THE PLACE DESCRIBED IN THE LICENSE FOR**
5 **ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION.**

6 **(C) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$500.**

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
8 1, 2018.
