 12 (PARCC) ASSESSMENT OR ITS EQUIVALENT ADMINISTERED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- (3) If a parent or guardian of a child refuses to allow the child to participate in a PARCC assessment or its equivalent administered under this section, the refusal shall be documented in the Individualized Education Program of the child required under \$ 8-405 of this article.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
