## Community Colleges - Facilities Renewal Grant Program - Established

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Community College Facilities Renewal Grant 4 Program; requiring the Maryland Higher Education Commission to administer the 5 Program; requiring the Governor to annually appropriate a certain amount in a 6 certain budget to the Commission; requiring a certain appropriation to be in addition 7 to the appropriation for a certain other program; requiring, by a certain date, a 8 community college to provide certain information to the Commission; establishing 9 requirements and limitations in awarding grants; requiring the Commission, in 10 collaboration with the community colleges, to adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms; and generally relating to a facility renewal grant program for 11 12 community colleges.
