2 **Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission – Indirect Customer Assistance**
3 **Program**

4 **PG/MC 105–18**

5 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission to
6 establish an Indirect Customer Assistance Program for certain purposes; requiring
7 the Commission to establish certain eligibility standards and processes for receiving
8 certain assistance if the program is established; requiring the program to be funded
9 from Commission revenues; requiring income eligibility standards for the program
10 to be uniformly applied throughout the sanitary district; defining certain terms; and
11 generally relating to customer assistance and rates of the Washington Suburban
12 Sanitary Commission.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Public Utilities**

2 (a) The Commission shall set a service rate that the Commission considers
3 necessary to provide funds for:

4 (1) maintaining, repairing, and operating its water supply and sewer
5 systems, including the overhead expense and depreciation allowance; and

6 (2) making any payments to the District of Columbia, as specified in this
7 title.

8 (b) The service rate:

9 (1) shall be chargeable against all properties for a connection with any line
10 owned by the Commission;

11 (2) shall be uniform throughout the sanitary district; and

12 (3) may be changed as necessary.

14 **(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS**
15 **INDICATED.**

16 **(2) "INDIRECT CUSTOMER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:**

17 **(I) RECEIVES WATER SERVICE OR SEWER SERVICE OR BOTH**
18 **FROM THE COMMISSION; BUT**

19 **(II) IS NOT BILLED BY THE COMMISSION FOR THE SERVICE.**

20 **(3) "RATEPAYER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO RECEIVES A BILL**
21 **DIRECTLY FROM THE COMMISSION FOR WATER SERVICE OR SEWER SERVICE OR**
22 **BOTH.**

23 **[(c) (B) (1) Notwithstanding any other law, on or before July 1, 2015, the**
24 **Commission shall establish a Customer Assistance Program to provide financial assistance**
25 **with water and sewer bills to eligible ratepayers.**

26 **(2) [(i)] The Commission shall establish income eligibility standards for**
27 **a ratepayer to receive financial assistance under this subsection.**

28 **[(ii) The income eligibility standards established under this**
29 **paragraph shall be applied uniformly throughout the sanitary district.**

1 (3) The Customer Assistance Program shall be funded from Commission
2 revenues.]

3 (C) (1) THE COMMISSION MAY ESTABLISH AN INDIRECT CUSTOMER
4 ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

5 (2) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL
6 ASSISTANCE TO ELIGIBLE INDIRECT CUSTOMERS FOR WATER AND SEWER SERVICE.

7 (3) IF THE COMMISSION ESTABLISHES A PROGRAM UNDER THIS
8 SUBSECTION, THE COMMISSION SHALL ESTABLISH INCOME ELIGIBILITY
9 STANDARDS AND A PROCESS FOR AN INDIRECT CUSTOMER TO RECEIVE FINANCIAL
10 ASSISTANCE UNDER THE PROGRAM.

11 (D) (1) THE CUSTOMER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM AND THE INDIRECT
12 CUSTOMER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SHALL BE FUNDED FROM COMMISSION
13 REVENUES.

14 (2) INCOME ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS FOR THE CUSTOMER
15 ASSISTANCE PROGRAM AND THE INDIRECT CUSTOMER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
16 SHALL BE APPLIED UNIFORMLY THROUGHOUT THE SANITARY DISTRICT.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
18 1, 2018.
