12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13	That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 **14.5–605**.
- A PERSON SHALL COMMENCE A JUDICIAL PROCEEDING TO CONTEST THE
  VALIDITY OF A TRUST THAT WAS REVOCABLE AT THE DEATH OF THE SETTLOR
  WITHIN THE EARLIEST OF:
- 19 (1) 1 YEAR AFTER THE DEATH OF THE SETTLOR; OR
- 20 (2) 6 MONTHS AFTER THE TRUSTEE SENDS THE PERSON A COPY OF 21 THE TRUST INSTRUMENT AND A NOTICE INFORMING THE PERSON OF THE 22 EXISTENCE OF THE TRUST, THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE TRUSTEE, AND THE 23 TIME ALLOWED FOR COMMENCING A PROCEEDING.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any action arising before the effective date of this Act.
