1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Utilities – Water or Sewage Disposal Systems – Rates**

3 FOR the purpose of allowing the Public Service Commission to authorize a certain rate
4 consolidation of two or more water or sewage disposal systems under certain
5 circumstances; defining the term “rate consolidation”; and generally relating to
6 water or sewage disposal systems.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Public Utilities**

15 **4–307.**

16 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, “RATE CONSOLIDATION” MEANS THE USE OF THE**
17 **SAME OR SIMILAR RATES OR TARIFF SCHEDULES OF RATES FOR CUSTOMERS OF THE**
18 **SAME CLASS FOR TWO OR MORE WATER OR SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS EVEN IF THE**
19 **SYSTEMS ARE NOT PHYSICALLY INTERCONNECTED.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

1 (B) AFTER NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS AND HOLDING A PUBLIC HEARING AND
2 AN EVIDENTIARY HEARING, THE COMMISSION MAY AUTHORIZE A RATE
3 CONSOLIDATION OF TWO OR MORE WATER OR SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS IF:

4 (1) THE WATER OR SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS HAVE COMMON
5 OWNERSHIP; AND

6 (2) THE RATE CONSOLIDATION IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2018.
