- 1 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT BE DENIED THE RIGHT TO PURCHASE, OWN, 2 POSSESS, OR CARRY A FIREARM UNDER THIS TITLE SOLELY ON THE BASIS THAT THE 3 PERSON IS A QUALIFYING PATIENT.
- 4 (C) A STATE AGENCY MAY NOT ACCESS A DATABASE CONTAINING THE 5 IDENTITIES OF QUALIFYING PATIENTS TO OBTAIN INFORMATION FOR THE PURPOSE 6 OF APPROVING OR DISAPPROVING A PERSON FROM PURCHASING, OWNING, 7 POSSESSING, OR CARRYING A FIREARM.

- 15 (F) ANY FORM USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPROVING OR DISAPPROVING
 16 A PERSON FROM PURCHASING, OWNING, POSSESSING, OR CARRYING A FIREARM
 17 THAT INQUIRES ABOUT THE APPLICANT'S USE OF CONTROLLED DANGEROUS
 18 SUBSTANCES SHALL SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZE A QUALIFYING PATIENT TO REFRAIN
 19 FROM REPORTING THE USE OF MEDICAL CANNABIS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2018.
