 Governor to provide a certain annual appropriation to county boards of education
 from the Education Trust Fund beginning in a certain fiscal year; prohibiting money
 in the Education Trust Fund from being used to supplant certain funding for certain
 programs and formulas; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the use of

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "DIRECT EDUCATION AID" MEANS THE TOTAL 19 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROVIDED BY THE STATE TO A COUNTY BOARD OF 20 EDUCATION UNDER THE FOLLOWING PROGRAMS:

(1) FUNDING FOR THE FOUNDATION PROGRAM, INCLUDING FUNDS
 FOR THE GEOGRAPHIC COST OF EDUCATION UNDER § 5–202 OF THE EDUCATION
 ARTICLE;

1 (2) TRANSPORTATION AID UNDER § 5–205 OF THE EDUCATION 2 ARTICLE;

3 (3) FUNDING FOR COMPENSATORY EDUCATION UNDER § 5–207 OF 4 THE EDUCATION ARTICLE;

5 (4) FUNDING FOR STUDENTS WITH LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENCY 6 UNDER § 5–208 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE;

7 (5) FUNDING FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION STUDENTS UNDER § 5–209 OF 8 THE EDUCATION ARTICLE; AND

11 [(a)] (B) There is an Education Trust Fund which is a special, nonlapsing fund 12 that is not subject to § 7–302 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

13 [(b)] (C) (1) There shall be credited to the Education Trust Fund all proceeds 14 allocated to the Fund under § 9–1A–27 of this subtitle.

15 (2) Money in the Education Trust Fund shall be invested and reinvested 16 by the Treasurer, and interest and earnings shall accrue to the Fund.

17 [(c)] (D) Money in the Education Trust Fund shall be used to:

18 (1) provide funding for public elementary and secondary education[, 19 through continuation of the funding and formulas established under the programs 20 commonly known as the Bridge to Excellence in Public Schools Act, first enacted by Chapter 21 288 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002, including the funding for regional 22 differences in the cost of education under § 5–202(f) of the Education Article];

(2) provide funds to construct public school buildings and provide public
 school capital improvements in accordance with §§ 5–301 through 5–303 of the Education
 Article; AND

26 (3) [provide funds for capital projects at community colleges and public 27 senior higher education institutions; and

(4)] provide funds to expand public early childhood education programs inthe State.

30 [(d) Expenditures from the Education Trust Fund shall be made each fiscal year 31 in accordance with the State budget.] 1 **(E)** (1) BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2020 AND IN EACH FISCAL YEAR $\mathbf{2}$ THEREAFTER, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPROPRIATE FROM THE EDUCATION TRUST FUND TO EACH COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE TOTAL 3 4 AMOUNT OF MONEY IN THE EDUCATION TRUST FUND MULTIPLIED BY THE RATIO OF THE DIRECT EDUCATION AID PROVIDED TO A COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION $\mathbf{5}$ DIVIDED BY THE TOTAL DIRECT EDUCATION AID PROVIDED TO ALL COUNTY BOARDS 6 7 OF EDUCATION.

8 (2) MONEY FROM THE EDUCATION TRUST FUND MAY NOT BE USED 9 TO SUPPLANT REQUIRED FUNDING FOR PROGRAMS OR FORMULAS ESTABLISHED 10 UNDER THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2018.
