- 17 (H) (1) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2019, AND AT LEAST ONCE EVERY 6 YEARS
- 18 THEREAFTER, THE OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE AUDITS SHALL CONDUCT AN AUDIT OF
