7	(B) BEFORE A COUNTY TRANSFERS AN ASSET OF THE COUNTY THAT IS
8	LOCATED IN A MUNICIPALITY AS PART OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF A HIGH-SPEED
9	TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM THAT PASSES THROUGH THE COUNTY, THE COUNTY
10	SHALL NEGOTIATE A WRITTEN AGREEMENT WITH THE MUNICIPALITY CONCERNING:
