- 4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a local government from requiring a license or permit, including a certain license, to install, maintain, inspect, replace, or service certain 5 6 wireless security systems; authorizing a local government to require providers and 7 operators of wireless security systems to comply with certain ordinances and obtain 8 certain registrations or permits; prohibiting a local government from requiring 9 providers and operators of wireless security systems to obtain electrical permits; 10 providing that wireless security systems are not exempt from certain laws; requiring wireless security systems to meet certain State and local codes; defining certain 11 12 terms; and generally relating to licenses and permits by a local government for wireless security systems. 13

- 17 (B) IF A WIRELESS SECURITY SYSTEM DOES NOT REQUIRE THE SUBMISSION

- 19 WITH THE STATE OR A LOCAL BUILDING CODE, A LOCAL GOVERNMENT MAY NOT
- 20 REQUIRE A AN ELECTRICAL LICENSE OR AN ELECTRICAL PERMIT TO INSTALL,
- 21 MAINTAIN, INSPECT, REPLACE, OR SERVICE THE WIRELESS SECURITY SYSTEM,

- 24 (I) REQUIRE A PERSON WHO PROVIDES WIRELESS SECURITY
- 25 SYSTEMS TO COMPLY WITH A LOCAL ALARM ORDINANCE OR OBTAIN AN ALARM
- 26 BUSINESS REGISTRATION OR PERMIT; AND
- 27 (II) REQUIRE A PERSON WHO OPERATES WIRELESS SECURITY
- 28 SYSTEMS OR CAUSES WIRELESS SECURITY SYSTEMS TO BE OPERATED TO COMPLY
- 29 WITH A LOCAL ALARM ORDINANCE OR OBTAIN AN ALARM SYSTEM REGISTRATION OR
- 30 **PERMIT.**
- 31 (2) A LOCAL GOVERNMENT MAY NOT REQUIRE A PERSON DESCRIBED
- 32 IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION TO OBTAIN AN ELECTRICAL PERMIT.
