A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Medical Laboratories – Advertising or Solicitation of Business – Repeal of**
3 **Prohibition**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing a prohibition on certain advertising or solicitation of business
5 for any medical laboratory from anyone except a physician or certain medical care
6 facilities; and generally relating to medical laboratories.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Health – General**

15 [17–215.

16 A person may not directly or indirectly advertise for or solicit business in this State
17 for any medical laboratory, regardless of location, from anyone except a physician, hospital,
18 medical laboratory, clinic, clinical installation, or other medical care facility.]

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 October 1, 2018.
