- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 5 – Calvert County

14 5–103.

15 (a) The County Commissioners may change an adopted budget [only by 16 resolutions that comply] IN ACCORDANCE with this section, the Maryland Constitution, 17 state laws or public local laws. Changes may not be subdivided to alter the applicability of 18 the requirements of this section.

19 (b) The County Commissioners by resolution may establish procedures for the 20 administrative transfer of appropriations between general classifications of expenditures 21 in the current expense budget within the same office or department, transfers between 22 departments, agencies, boards or commissions, interproject transfers of appropriations 23 between capital projects in the capital budget, and the addition, of new budget items.

1 (c) Any change involving funds totaling more than \$100,000 may be made only 2 by resolution approved by the Commissioners after compliance with the publication and 3 hearing requirements applicable to the original proposed budget.

4 (d) To meet a public emergency affecting life, health, or property, the 5 Commissioners by resolution may make emergency appropriations from contingent or 6 surplus funds.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2018.
