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## Transportation - Complete Streets Policy - Adoption

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Transportation Authority and certain modal 4 administrations of the Department of Transportation to adopt a complete streets 5 policy that requires the implementation of certain complete streets design features 6 for certain facilities under certain circumstances; specifying the requirements of a 7 complete streets policy; exempting the Authority and certain modal administrations of the Department from adopting certain facets of a complete streets policy under 8 9 certain circumstances; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the adoption 10 of a complete streets policy by the Authority and certain modal administrations of 11 the Department.

- 17 (C) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, A
- 18 COMPLETE STREETS POLICY ADOPTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION SHALL:
- 19 (1) BE IMPLEMENTED WITH THE OBJECTIVE OF CREATING A
- 20 COMPREHENSIVE, INTEGRATED, AND CONNECTED TRANSPORTATION NETWORK
