A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Baltimore City – Alcoholic Beverages – Class A–7 License

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Baltimore City to 4 issue a Class A-7 beer, wine, and liquor license; establishing that the license $\mathbf{5}$ authorizes the holder to sell alcoholic beverages for off-premises consumption 7 days 6 a week during certain hours; providing that license holders who hold a certain class 7 of license are eligible to exchange that license for a Class A-7 license; providing that 8 a Class A–7 license can be issued only until a certain date; establishing an annual 9 license fee for a Class A–7 license; providing that the issuance, transfer, or renewal of a Class A-7 license is complete without certain zoning approval or verification; 1011 and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Baltimore City.
