A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Education - Summer Meals Expansion Grant Pilot Program

FOR the purpose of establishing the Summer Meals Expansion Grant Pilot Program; providing for the purpose of the Program; requiring the State Department of Education to administer the Program; authorizing certain uses of funds under the Program; establishing that funds distributed under the Program shall be used to supplement and not supplant certain other funding; requiring a certain applicant to submit a certain plan, agree to operate a site for a certain time period, and comply with certain other requirements for a grant awarded under the Program; requiring the Department to award grants according to certain priorities; requiring the Department to establish certain procedures; establishing the Summer Meals Expansion Grant Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund; specifying the purpose of the Fund; requiring the Department to administer the Fund; requiring the State Treasurer to hold the Fund separately, and the Comptroller to account for the Fund; specifying the contents of the Fund; specifying the purpose for which the Fund may be used; providing for the investment of money in and expenditures from the Fund; authorizing the Governor to make a certain annual appropriation for the Fund; requiring the Department to submit a certain report to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date each year; requiring the Department to consult with certain stakeholders to develop a certain statewide plan, undertake certain activities in developing the plan, and submit the plan to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the Summer Meals Expansion Grant Pilot Program.

- 25 (II) ANY INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE 26 CREDITED TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.
- 27 (8) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN

- 2 (9) THE GOVERNOR MAY ANNUALLY APPROPRIATE UP TO \$400,000

- 19 (1) evaluate outcome data from the Summer Meals Expansion Grant Pilot 20 Program established by Section 1 of this Act;
- 21 (2) consider and recommend strategies to increase the number of children
- 22 and the number of meals served through the Summer Food Service Program; and
- 23 (3) consider and recommend strategies to increase access to meals for
- 24 children in rural school districts.
- 25 (c) On or before December 1, 2020, the Department shall submit the statewide
- 26 plan to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article,
- 27 the General Assembly.
