BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 13 14 **Article – Transportation** 15 21 - 902.2.In this section, "ignition interlock system" means a device that: 16 (a) 17 Connects a motor vehicle ignition system to a breath analyzer that (1) 18 measures a driver's blood alcohol level; [and] 19 (2)Prevents a motor vehicle ignition from starting if a driver's blood 20 alcohol level exceeds the calibrated setting on the device; AND 21 **(3)** HAS A CAMERA CAPABLE OF RECORDING THE IMAGE OF THE
