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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages – License Fees**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing certain license fees for Class B licenses with off-sale liquor  
4 privileges in Harford County; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses  
5 in Harford County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
7 Article – Alcoholic Beverages  
8 Section 22–102 and 22–906(a)  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (2016 Volume and 2017 Supplement)

11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
12 Article – Alcoholic Beverages  
13 Section 22–906(e)  
14 Annotated Code of Maryland  
15 (2016 Volume and 2017 Supplement)

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

19 22–102.

3 (a) There is a Class BNR (newly opened restaurant) beer, wine, and liquor license.

4 (e) [(1) The annual license fee is \$3,000.

5 [(2) Additional fees for Class B licenses with off-sale liquor privileges are:

6 (i) \$350, for a 6-day license; and

7 (ii) \$450, for a 7-day license.]

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
9 1, 2018.
