## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Telephone Companies – Unpublished Telephone Number – One-Time Charge**

3 FOR the purpose of limiting the number of times a telephone company may assess a fee to  
4 a customer for keeping certain telephone numbers unpublished; authorizing a  
5 telephone company to assess the fee each time a customer changes the customer's  
6 telephone number; and generally relating to telephone companies.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Public Utilities**

15 **8–207.**

16 **(A) IF A TELEPHONE COMPANY ASSESSES A CHARGE TO A CUSTOMER FOR**  
17 **KEEPING THE CUSTOMER'S TELEPHONE NUMBER UNPUBLISHED, THE TELEPHONE**

1 COMPANY MAY ASSESS THE CHARGE ONLY ONE TIME FOR EACH TELEPHONE  
2 NUMBER ON THE CUSTOMER’S ACCOUNT.

3 (B) A TELEPHONE COMPANY MAY ASSESS THE ONE-TIME CHARGE  
4 AUTHORIZED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION EACH TIME A CUSTOMER  
5 CHANGES THE CUSTOMER’S TELEPHONE NUMBER.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
7 October 1, 2018.
