A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages – Polling Places on Election Days**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting in Harford County a license holder whose premises are used
4 as a polling place from exercising any privilege conferred by the license on the day of
5 an election when the polls are open; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages
6 licenses in Harford County.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

20 22–102.

21 This title applies only in Harford County.

3 **AN ELECTION WHEN THE POLLS ARE OPEN.**

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
5 1, 2018.
