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## Vehicle Laws - Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the use of a pedestrian hybrid beacon at certain locations; authorizing the State Highway Administration or a local jurisdiction to install a modified pedestrian hybrid beacon in accordance with certain standards under certain circumstances; requiring the Administration to update certain standards to incorporate certain information on or before a certain date; defining certain terms; and generally relating to pedestrian hybrid beacons.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Transportation
- 17 **21–204.2.**
- 18 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 19 INDICATED.
- 20 (2) "ADMINISTRATION" MEANS THE STATE HIGHWAY
- 21 ADMINISTRATION.
- 22 (3) "PEDESTRIAN HYBRID BEACON" MEANS A TRAFFIC CONTROL
- 23 SIGNAL PLACED AT A CROSSWALK THAT:



- 1 (I) USES A COMBINATION OF STEADY AND FLASHING LIGHTS
- 2 TO ALERT AND STOP TRAFFIC APPROACHING THE CROSSWALK TO ALLOW
- 3 PEDESTRIANS TO CROSS A MAIN ROADWAY; AND
- 4 (II) IS PEDESTRIAN-ACTIVATED.
- 5 (B) A PEDESTRIAN HYBRID BEACON MAY BE USED AT AN INTERSECTION OR 6 A MIDBLOCK PEDESTRIAN CROSSING.
- 7 (C) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2018, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL 8 UPDATE THE MARYLAND MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES TO
- 9 INCORPORATE DETAILS REGARDING THE PROPER OPERATION OF A PEDESTRIAN
- 10 HYBRID BEACON IN THE STATE.
- 11 (D) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION,
- 12 THE ADMINISTRATION OR A LOCAL JURISDICTION MAY INSTALL A PEDESTRIAN
- 13 HYBRID BEACON IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MARYLAND MANUAL ON UNIFORM
- 14 TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES.
- 15 (2) IF THE MARYLAND MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL
- 16 DEVICES HAS NOT BEEN UPDATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS
- 17 SECTION, THE ADMINISTRATION OR A LOCAL JURISDICTION MAY INSTALL A
- 18 PEDESTRIAN HYBRID BEACON ONLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FEDERAL MANUAL
- 19 ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
