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## Local Pension Systems - Special Disability Retirement Allowance

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring that the appropriate authority of a local pension system grant 4 offer a special disability retirement allowance to certain members under certain 5 circumstances; providing for the calculation of a special disability retirement 6 allowance; exempting the appropriate authority of a local pension system from the 7 requirements of this Act under certain circumstances; providing for the application 8 of this Act; requiring a local pension system, on or before a certain date, to notify 9 certain participants affected by this Act of their right to an adjusted benefit: defining certain terms; and generally relating to local pension systems and special disability 10 11 retirement allowances.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 6 (3) "ALLOWANCE" MEANS A BENEFIT THAT IS PAYABLE IN EQUAL
- 7 MONTHLY INSTALLMENTS FOR THE LIFE OF THE RECIPIENT, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE
- 8 PROVIDED FOR UNDER A LOCAL PENSION SYSTEM.
- 9 (4) "ALTERNATIVE SUITABLE EMPLOYMENT" MEANS EMPLOYMENT
- 10 THAT HAS SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR PAY, BENEFITS, AND ADVANCEMENT
- 11 OPPORTUNITIES BASE PAY, SALARY SCHEDULE, AND GRADE AS THE POSITION THAT
- 12 THE MEMBER HELD WHEN THE APPROPRIATE AUTHORITY OF A LOCAL PENSION
- 13 SYSTEM DETERMINED THAT THE MEMBER WAS ELIGIBLE FOR THE GRANT OFFER OF
- 14 A SPECIAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS

- 16 (5) "ANNUITY" MEANS THE PART OF AN ALLOWANCE THAT IS 17 DERIVED FROM THE ACCUMULATED CONTRIBUTIONS OF A MEMBER.
- 18 (6) "AVERAGE FINAL COMPENSATION" MEANS THE AVERAGE ANNUAL
- 19 EARNABLE COMPENSATION THAT IS COMPUTED UNDER THE RULES OF A LOCAL
- 20 PENSION SYSTEM.
- 21 (7) "EARNABLE COMPENSATION" MEANS ONE-TWELFTH OF THE
- 22 MEMBER'S ANNUAL SALARY RATE PAYABLE FOR WORKING THE NORMAL TIME IN THE
- 23 MEMBER'S POSITION, INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING, IF APPLICABLE:
- 24 (I) THE EMPLOYER PICKUP CONTRIBUTION; OR
- 25 (II) A CONTRIBUTION MADE UNDER A SALARY REDUCTION OR
- 26 SUPPLEMENTAL RETIREMENT PLAN.
- 27 (8) "Interest" means interest at the rate payable on
- 28 ACCUMULATED CONTRIBUTIONS AS PROVIDED UNDER THE RULES OF THE LOCAL
- 29 PENSION SYSTEM.
- 30 (9) "LOCAL GOVERNMENT" MEANS ANY COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL
- 31 CORPORATION OF THE STATE.
- 32 (10) (I) "LOCAL PENSION SYSTEM" MEANS A RETIREMENT OR
- 33 PENSION PLAN OR SYSTEM ESTABLISHED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF A UNIT OF

- 1 LOCAL GOVERNMENT THAT MAY ESTABLISH A QUALIFIED PLAN UNDER § 401(A) OF
- 2 THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE AND PROVIDES A DEFINED BENEFIT TO ITS
- 3 PARTICIPANTS.
- 4 (II) "LOCAL PENSION SYSTEM" DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY OF THE
- 5 STATE SYSTEMS SPECIFIED IN § 21–102 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 6 (11) "MEMBER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:
- 7 (I) IS EMPLOYED <del>IN A LAW ENFORCEMENT, PUBLIC SAFETY, OR</del>
- 8 EMERGENCY RESPONSE POSITION AS A SWORN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, A FIRE
- 9 FIGHTER, OR AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN; AND
- 10 (II) 1. IS A MEMBER OF A LOCAL PENSION SYSTEM AS A
- 11 CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT; OR
- 12 2. HAS ELECTED TO BECOME A MEMBER OF A LOCAL
- 13 PENSION SYSTEM.

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- 14 (12) "NORMAL RETIREMENT AGE" MEANS THE AGE AT WHICH A
- 15 MEMBER IS ELIGIBLE TO RETIRE WITH A NORMAL SERVICE RETIREMENT
- 16 ALLOWANCE AS PROVIDED UNDER THE RULES OF THE LOCAL PENSION SYSTEM.
- 17 (13) "PARTICIPANT" MEANS A BENEFICIARY, DESIGNATED
- 18 BENEFICIARY, FORMER MEMBER, MEMBER, OR RETIREE WHO IS OR MAY BECOME
- 19 ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A BENEFIT AT ANY TIME UNDER A LOCAL PENSION SYSTEM.

2	MENTALLY OR PHYSICALLY, FOR THE FURTHER PERFORMANCE OF DUTY;
3	(II) THE INCAPACITY IS LIKELY TO BE PERMANENT; AND
4	(III) THE MEMBER SHOULD BE RETIRED.
5	(D) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION, A SPECIAL
6	DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE EQUALS THE <del>LESSER</del> <u>GREATER</u> OF:
7	(1) THE MEMBER'S AVERAGE FINAL COMPENSATION AN ALLOWANCE
8	SET BY TERMS OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING OR BY LOCAL PENSION DISABILITY LAW;
9	OR
10	(2) THE SUM OF:
11	(I) AN ANNUITY THAT IS THE ACTUARIAL EQUIVALENT OF THE
12	MEMBER'S ACCUMULATED CONTRIBUTIONS AT RETIREMENT; AND
13	(II) A PENSION EQUAL TO <del>TWO-THIRDS</del> <u>50%</u> OF THE MEMBER'S
14	AVERAGE FINAL COMPENSATION OFFSET BY ANY INCOME FROM WORKERS'
15	COMPENSATION AND GOVERNMENT-SPONSORED DISABILITY BENEFITS.
16	(E) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO A MEMBER WHO IS AT LEAST
17	NORMAL RETIREMENT AGE.
18	(2) A SPECIAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE EQUALS THE
19	GREATER OF:
20	(I) A NORMAL SERVICE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE; OR
21	(II) A SPECIAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE
22	COMPUTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION.
23	(F) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE
24	APPROPRIATE AUTHORITY OF A LOCAL PENSION SYSTEM IS EXEMPTED FROM THE
25	REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION IF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT:
26	(I) PROVIDES THE MEMBER WITH ALTERNATIVE SUITABLE
27	EMPLOYMENT <del>; AND</del>
28	(II) PAYS FOR THE TRAINING OR RETRAINING OF THE MEMBER.

1 2 3 4	(2) IN DETERMINING WHETHER A POSITION IS CONSIDERED ALTERNATIVE SUITABLE EMPLOYMENT, THE APPROPRIATE AUTHORITY OF A LOCAL PENSION SYSTEM AND THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT SHALL CONSIDER THE NATURE AND EXTENT OF THE INCAPACITY OF THE MEMBER.
5 6 7 8	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect a member or former member of a local pension system who was injured in the line of duty on or after July 1, 2015.
9 10 11	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before October 1, 2018, a local pension system shall notify the participants who are affected by this Act of their right to an adjusted benefit in accordance with this Act.
12 13	SECTION 4. 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
