A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Drivers’ Schools – Age of Instruction Vehicles**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the use of certain vehicles that are older than a certain
4 number of model years for instruction in a drivers’ school; specifying that this Act
5 does not apply to commercial vehicles; and generally relating to drivers’ schools.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Transportation**

14 15–708.

15 (A) Each licensee shall maintain all vehicles used for instruction in the condition
16 that the Administration requires.

17 (B) (1) **THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A COMMERCIAL MOTOR**
18 **VEHICLE.**

19 (2) **A VEHICLE THAT IS OLDER THAN 10 MODEL YEARS MAY NOT BE**
20 **USED FOR INSTRUCTION IN A DRIVERS’ SCHOOL.**

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 2018.
