## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages – Sunday Sales at a Bar or Counter**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the prohibition against holders of certain alcoholic beverages  
4 licenses in Harford County from selling certain alcoholic beverages at a bar or  
5 counter on Sunday; and generally relating to the sale of alcoholic beverages in  
6 Harford County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

4 and wine license may sell beer and wine on Monday through Sunday, from 8 a.m. to 2 a.m.

7 Sunday.]

8 (c) [(1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, a] **A** holder of a Class C beer  
9 and wine license may sell beer and wine on Monday through Sunday, from 8 a.m. to 2 a.m.  
10 the following day.

11 [(2) The license holder may not sell beer or wine at a bar or counter on  
12 Sunday.]

14 (b) [(1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, a] **A** holder of a Class B  
15 beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor on Monday through Sunday,  
16 from 8 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day.

17 [(2) The license holder may not sell beer, wine, or liquor at a bar or counter  
18 on Sunday.]

19 (c) [(1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, a] **A** holder of a Class B–3  
20 beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor:

21 [(i)] **(1)** for a 6–day license, on Monday through Saturday, from 8  
22 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day; and

23 [(ii)] **(2)** for a 7–day license, on Monday through Sunday, from 8  
24 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day.

25 [(2) The license holder may not sell beer, wine, or liquor at a bar or counter  
26 on Sunday.]

27 (f) (1) This subsection applies to Class C–1, C–2, and C–3 (on–sale)  
28 organization or club beer, wine, and liquor licenses.

29 (2) A holder of a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine,  
30 and liquor:

1 (i) for a 6–day license, on Monday through Saturday, from 8 a.m. to  
2 2 a.m. the following day; and

3 (ii) for a 7–day license, on Monday through Sunday, from 8 a.m. to 2  
4 a.m. the following day.

5 [(3) The license holder may not sell beer, wine, and liquor at a bar or counter  
6 on Sunday.]

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
8 1, 2018.
