14 15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
16	Article - Alcoholic Beverages
17	2–308.
18	(a) There is a Class 7 limited beer wholesaler's license.
19	(b) The license may be issued only to a person that:
20 21	(1) holds a Class 5 manufacturer's license, a Class 7 micro-brewery license, or a Class 8 farm brewery license; and
22	(2) produces in the aggregate from all of its locations not more than



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[22,500] **300,000** barrels of beer annually. 1 2 The license authorizes the license holder to: (c) 3 (1) sell and deliver its own beer produced at the license holder's premises 4 to: 5 a holder of a retail license that is authorized to acquire beer from (i) 6 a wholesaler; and 7 a holder of a permit that is authorized to acquire beer from a (ii) 8 wholesaler; and 9 (2)distribute [not more than 3,000 barrels of] its own beer [annually]. 10 (d) The annual license fee is \$50. The license holder may use an additional location for the warehousing, sale, 11 and delivery of beer: 12 13 (1) if approved by the Comptroller following submission of a separate application for each location; and 14 15 (2)on the payment of a \$50 fee for each additional location. 16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 October 1, 2018.
