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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **County Boards of Education – Collection and Sharing of Student Data – Policy**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a county board of education, in conjunction with a local  
4 health department, to develop and implement a policy and procedures for the  
5 collection and sharing of certain student data for certain purposes; requiring a  
6 certain policy include certain provisions; requiring a certain policy and certain  
7 procedures to comply with the requirements of a certain federal law; and generally  
8 relating to a county board of education policy for the collection and sharing of student  
9 data.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Education**

18 **7–441.**

19 **(A) A COUNTY BOARD, JOINTLY WITH A LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH,**  
20 **MAY DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A POLICY AND PROCEDURES FOR THE COLLECTION**  
21 **AND SHARING OF STUDENT DATA FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSISTING THE LOCAL**  
22 **DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH IN:**

23 **(1) IDENTIFYING, UNDERSTANDING, AND DEVELOPING PROGRAMS**  
24 **TO IMPROVE THE PUBLIC HEALTH OUTCOMES OF STUDENTS AND OTHER**

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EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 INDIVIDUALS IN THE COUNTY; AND

2 (2) RESPONDING TO URGENT PUBLIC HEALTH MATTERS AFFECTING  
3 THE CITIZENS OF THE COUNTY AS THOSE ISSUES ARISE.

4 (B) A POLICY DEVELOPED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE:

5 (1) A NOTICE TO PARENTS AND GUARDIANS EXPLAINING THE POLICY;

6 (2) AN OPPORTUNITY FOR A PARENT OR GUARDIAN TO OPT OUT OF  
7 THE COLLECTION AND SHARING OF THEIR CHILD'S PERSONAL INFORMATION; AND

8 (3) PROVISIONS THAT ADDRESS THE HANDLING OF DE-IDENTIFIED  
9 AND PERSONALLY IDENTIFYING DATA.

10 (C) A POLICY AND PROCEDURES DEVELOPED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL  
11 COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE FEDERAL FAMILY EDUCATIONAL  
12 RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
14 1, 2018.
