## State Procurement – Use of Electronic Means to Conduct Procurement

- FOR the purpose of requiring, beginning on a certain date, a primary procurement unit to conduct procurement by a certain electronic means; authorizing a bidder or an offeror to elect to submit a bid or an offer and to conduct each element of a certain procurement contract in hard copy form; and generally relating to the use of electronic means by primary procurement units to conduct State procurements.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 17 (a) (1) Unless otherwise prohibited by law, **BEFORE JULY 1, 2020,** a primary
- 18 procurement unit may conduct procurement, including the solicitation, bidding, award,

- 20 Electronic Transactions Act in Title 21 of the Commercial Law Article.
