- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (A) A POLICE OFFICER MAY NOT BASE THE AUTHORITY TO SEARCH A MOTOR 19 VEHICLE, AS DEFINED IN § 11–135 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE, SOLELY ON 20 THE OFFICER OBTAINING THE CONSENT OF THE OWNER OR OCCUPANT OF THE 21 MOTOR VEHICLE.

22 **(B) (1)** ANY SEARCH OF A MOTOR VEHICLE CONDUCTED IN VIOLATION OF 23 THIS SECTION IS UNREASONABLE.
