15 A SOIL PERCOLATION TEST PERFORMED ON AN UNIMPROVED PROPERTY 16 REMAINS VALID FOR THE PROPERTY IF:

17 (1) A SATISFACTORY SOIL PERCOLATION TEST IS FILED WITH THE 18 APPROPRIATE UNIT OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE PROPERTY IS LOCATED; AND

19(2)THE PROPERTY HAS NOT BEEN ALTERED SINCE THE DATE OF THE20SOIL PERCOLATION TEST.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 October 1, 2018.
