- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **24–308.**

17 (A) ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2020, A PERSON MAY NOT SELL OR 18 DISTRIBUTE IN COMMERCE ANY COMMERCIAL OR CONSUMER AEROSOL DEGREASER 19 OR A SPOT CLEANER FOR DRY CLEANING THAT CONTAINS TRICHLOROETHYLENE 20 (TCE).

(B) A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION OR ANY REGULATION
ADOPTED BY THE SECRETARY TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000
FOR EACH VIOLATION.
