- 4 (B) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL PLACE AND MAINTAIN DONATION 5 BOXES AT THE ENTRANCE TO EACH SECURITY SCREENING CHECKPOINT AT THE 6 BALTIMORE–WASHINGTON INTERNATIONAL THURGOOD MARSHALL AIRPORT.
- 7 (C) THE MONEY DEPOSITED IN THE DONATION BOXES REQUIRED UNDER 8 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE:
- 9 (1) APPROPRIATED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PROGRAM; AND
- 10 (2) USED TO SUPPLEMENT, BUT NOT SUPPLANT, ANY OTHER 11 FUNDING AVAILABLE FOR THE PROGRAM.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2018.
