## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning 2 Education - Maryland Meals for Achievement In-Classroom Breakfast Program 3 - Eligibility and Annual Appropriation 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain schools to remain eligible to participate in the 5 Maryland Meals for Achievement In-Classroom Breakfast Program under certain 6 circumstances; requiring the Governor to include a certain appropriation to the 7 Program in the annual budget bill; defining certain terms; and generally relating to 8 the Maryland Meals for Achievement In-Classroom Breakfast Program. 9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 10 Article – Education Section 7-704 11 Annotated Code of Maryland 12 (2014 Replacement Volume and 2017 Supplement) 13 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Education 16 17 7 - 704. 18 (a) **(1)** In this section[,] THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED. 19 20 **(2)** "Program" means the Maryland Meals for Achievement In-Classroom 21Breakfast Program.

"SECONDARY SCHOOLS" INCLUDES HIGH SCHOOLS.

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- 1 (b) (1) There is a school breakfast program in the State, known as the 2 Maryland Meals for Achievement In–Classroom Breakfast Program.
- 3 (2) The Program is a joint effort of the Department and the county boards 4 or sponsoring agencies for eligible nonpublic schools.
- 5 (c) (1) The purpose of the Program is to provide funding for a school that 6 makes an in-classroom breakfast available to all students in the school.
- 7 (2) The funding is intended to complement the funding received by a school 8 from the federal government for a school breakfast program.
- 9 (d) The Department shall:
- 10 (1) Develop an application form for a school that desires to participate in 11 the Program;
- 12 (2) Ensure that the schools that participate in the Program represent 13 geographic and socioeconomic balance statewide;
- 14 (3) [Ensure] SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION, ENSURE 15 that a school that participates in the Program is a school at which at least 40% of the 16 registered students are eligible for the federal free or reduced price meal program;
- 17 (4) Select schools to participate in the Program, ensuring that an annual evaluation of the Program is conducted by the Department;
- 19 (5) Annually review and set the meal reimbursement rate for schools that 20 participate in the Program to complement the federal meal reimbursement rate determined 21 under § 7–703 of this subtitle; and
- 22 (6) Disburse the Program funds to the county board or the sponsoring 23 agency.
- (E) (1) IF A SCHOOL THAT PARTICIPATES IN THE PROGRAM HAS LESS THAN 40% OF THE REGISTERED STUDENTS ELIGIBLE FOR THE FEDERAL FREE OR REDUCED PRICE MEAL PLAN, THE SCHOOL SHALL REMAIN ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM FOR 1 YEAR.
- 28 (2) IF, AFTER 1 YEAR, THE SCHOOL'S PERCENT OF REGISTERED STUDENTS ELIGIBLE FOR THE FEDERAL FREE OR REDUCED PRICE MEAL PLAN IS LESS THAN 40%, THE SCHOOL IS NO LONGER ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 31 PROGRAM.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
