- 17 WHEREAS, The spotted turtle is a species of turtle found throughout Maryland; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The spotted turtle population is declining due to habitat destruction and
- 19 alteration, including saltwater intrusion due to sea level rise, collection for the pet trade,
- 20 vehicle mortality, and other human impacts; and
- 21WHEREAS, It is estimated that the current maximum population of spotted turtle
- 22is 1,205; and
- 23 WHEREAS, February 17 is recognized nationally as Random Act of Kindness Day
- 24and is an appropriate date on which to raise awareness about spotted turtles; now,

- 2 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 3 That Section(s) 7–402 through 7–417, respectively, of Article General Provisions of the
- 4 Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7-403 through 7-418,
- 5 respectively.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read 7 as follows:
- 8 Article General Provisions
- 9 7-402.
- THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM FEBRUARY 17 AS SPOTTED TURTLE AWARENESS DAY.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2018.
