#### A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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### Public Safety - Deaths Involving a Correctional Officer - Reports

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring State and local correctional facilities annually to provide the 4 Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention with certain information on 5 correctional officer-involved deaths and deaths in the line of duty; requiring the 6 Office to adopt certain procedures for collecting and analyzing certain information; 7 requiring the Office to analyze and disseminate certain information; requiring the 8 Office to report certain information on correctional officer-involved deaths and 9 deaths in the line of duty to the General Assembly on or before a certain date; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the reporting of correctional 10 11 officer-involved deaths and deaths in the line of duty.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article Public Safety
- 20 **3-520.**
- 21 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 22 INDICATED.
- 23 (2) "CORRECTIONAL FACILITY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN §
- 24 1-101 OF THE CORRECTIONAL SERVICES ARTICLE.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

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$1\\2$	(3) (I) "CORRECTIONAL OFFICER" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 8–201 OF THE CORRECTIONAL SERVICES ARTICLE.
3 4	(II) "CORRECTIONAL OFFICER" INCLUDES A PRIVATE OFFICER PERFORMING DUTIES AS A PART OF A CONTRACT WITH A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.
5 6 7 8 9	(4) "DEATH IN THE LINE OF DUTY" MEANS THE DEATH OF A CORRECTIONAL OFFICER WHILE THE OFFICER IS ACTING IN THE OFFICER'S OFFICIAL CAPACITY WHILE ON DUTY OR WHILE THE OFFICER IS OFF DUTY BUT PERFORMING ACTIVITIES THAT ARE WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE OFFICER'S OFFICIAL DUTIES.
10 11 12	(5) (I) "Inmate death" means the death of an adult or a Juvenile occurring while the individual is under the supervision of a local or State correctional entity.
13 14	(II) "INMATE DEATH" INCLUDES THE DEATH OF AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER SUPERVISION AT:
15	1. A LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY;
16	2. A BOOKING FACILITY;
17	3. A DETENTION CENTER;
18	4. A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY;
19	5. A MEDICAL TREATMENT RELEASE CENTER;
20	6. A HALFWAY HOUSE;
21	7. A WORK DETAIL; OR

23 (B) ON OR BEFORE MARCH 1, 2019, AND ON OR BEFORE MARCH 1 EACH
24 YEAR THEREAFTER, EACH STATE AND LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY SHALL
25 PROVIDE THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION WITH
26 INFORMATION, FOR THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR, ABOUT EACH INMATE DEATH
27 AND DEATH IN THE LINE OF DUTY THAT INVOLVED A CORRECTIONAL OFFICER
28 ASSIGNED TO THE FACILITY, TO INCLUDE AT A MINIMUM:

A TEMPORARY HOLDING OR LOCKUP FACILITY.

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- 1 (1) THE AGE, GENDER, ETHNICITY, AND RACE OF A DECEASED 2 INDIVIDUAL;
- 3 (2) THE AGE, GENDER, ETHNICITY, AND RACE OF THE CORRECTIONAL 4 OFFICER INVOLVED;
- 5 (3) A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING 6 THE DEATH;
- 7 (4) THE DATE, TIME, AND LOCATION OF THE DEATH;
- 8 (5) IF APPLICABLE, ANY MENTAL ILLNESS OR OTHER DISABILITY OF 9 THE DECEASED INDIVIDUAL; AND
- 10 **(6)** THE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY OF THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICER 11 WHO:
- 12 (I) DIED, IF THE INCIDENT INVOLVED A CORRECTIONAL 13 OFFICER WHO DIED IN THE LINE OF DUTY; OR
- 14 (II) SUPERVISED OR HAD CUSTODY OR CONTROL OF THE 15 DECEASED, IF THE INCIDENT INVOLVED AN OFFICER-INVOLVED DEATH.
- 16 (C) THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION
  17 SHALL ADOPT PROCEDURES FOR THE COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS OF THE
  18 INFORMATION DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- 19 (D) THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION 20 SHALL ANALYZE AND DISSEMINATE THE INFORMATION PROVIDED UNDER 21 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- 22 (E) THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION 23 SHALL MAKE AN ANNUAL REPORT ON THE INCIDENCE OF CORRECTIONAL 24 OFFICER-INVOLVED DEATHS AND DEATHS IN THE LINE OF DUTY IN THE STATE TO 25 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF THE STATE 26 GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30 EACH YEAR.

## 27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

28 (a) On or before August 15, 2018, each local law enforcement agency shall provide 29 the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention with the information described in § 3–520(b) of the Public Safety Article as enacted by this Act for the previous 3 calendar year 31 period.

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- 1 (b) On or before October 15, 2018, the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, on the number of correctional officer—involved deaths and deaths in the line of duty that occurred during the previous 3 calendar years.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 6  $\,$  1, 2018.
