- 2 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT DRIVE OR ATTEMPT TO DRIVE A VEHICLE IN THE
- 3 STATE THAT HAS AN OUT-OF-STATE OR FOREIGN TEMPORARY OR TEMPORARY
- 4 TRANSPORTER REGISTRATION THAT ON ISSUANCE WAS VALID FOR 90 DAYS OR
- 5 FEWER UNLESS THE REGISTRATION COMPLIES WITH THE LAWS OF THE ISSUING
- 6 JURISDICTION.
- 7 (B) A PERSON CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT

- 9 (1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500; OR
- 10 (2) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, A FINE NOT
- 11 **EXCEEDING \$1,000.**

- 13 (a) After the conviction of an individual for a violation of Title 2, Subtitle 5, §
- 14 2–209, § 3–211, or § 10–110 of the Criminal Law Article, or of the vehicle laws or regulations
- of this State or of any local authority, points shall be assessed against the individual as of
- 16 the date of violation and as follows:
- 17 (16) ANY VIOLATION OF § 13–405.1 OF THIS ARTICLE...... 3 POINTS
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
