A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State and Local Correctional Facilities – Undocumented Immigrants – Transfer**
3 **to United States Department of Homeland Security**
4 **(Keep Our Communities Safe Act of 2018)**

5 FOR the purpose of requiring a State or local correctional facility with custody of a certain
6 undocumented immigrant to transfer the individual to the United States
7 Department of Homeland Security under certain circumstances; and generally
8 relating to undocumented immigrants and State and local correctional facilities.

10 Article – Correctional Services

11 Section 9–616

12 Annotated Code of Maryland

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Correctional Services**

17 **9–616.**

18 **ON REQUEST OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND**
19 **SECURITY, A STATE OR LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY WITH CUSTODY OF AN**
20 **UNDOCUMENTED IMMIGRANT WHO IS SERVING A SENTENCE IN THE FACILITY FOR**

1 **CONVICTION OF A CRIME SHALL TRANSFER THE INDIVIDUAL TO THE UNITED**
2 **STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY.**

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
4 October 1, 2018.
