# A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

# 2 Sales and Use Tax – Tax–Free Periods – University and College Textbooks

- FOR the purpose of designating certain periods each year to be tax-free periods during which an exemption from the sales and use tax is provided for the sale of certain textbooks purchased by certain individuals; defining a certain term; and generally relating to sales and use tax-free periods for the sale of university and college textbooks.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
  14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Tax General
  - 16 **11–234.**
  - 17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "TEXTBOOK" MEANS A BOOK:
  - 18(1) WRITTEN, DESIGNED, AND PRODUCED FOR EDUCATIONAL,19INSTRUCTIONAL, OR PEDAGOGICAL PURPOSES; AND

20 (2) REQUIRED FOR A COURSE AT A COMMUNITY COLLEGE 21 ESTABLISHED UNDER TITLE 16 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, A PRIVATE 22 NONPROFIT INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION AS DEFINED IN § 10–101(K) OF



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1 THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, A PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION AS 2 DEFINED IN § 10–101(M) OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, OR A REGIONAL HIGHER 3 EDUCATION CENTER AS DEFINED IN § 10–101(N) OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.

4 (B) (1) BEGINNING IN CALENDAR YEAR 2018, THE LAST 7 DAYS OF 5 AUGUST SHALL BE A TAX-FREE PERIOD FOR RETURN-TO-SCHOOL SHOPPING IN 6 MARYLAND DURING WHICH THE EXEMPTION UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS 7 SUBSECTION SHALL APPLY.

8 (2) BEGINNING IN CALENDAR YEAR 2019, IN ADDITION TO THE 9 TAX-FREE PERIOD ESTABLISHED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE 10 LAST 7 DAYS OF JANUARY SHALL BE A TAX-FREE PERIOD FOR RETURN-TO-SCHOOL 11 SHOPPING IN MARYLAND DURING WHICH THE EXEMPTION UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) 12 OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL APPLY.

13(3) DURING THE TAX-FREE PERIODS FOR RETURN-TO-SCHOOL SHOPPING ESTABLISHED UNDER PARAGRAPHS (1) AND (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, 14THE SALES AND USE TAX DOES NOT APPLY TO THE SALE OF A TEXTBOOK THAT IS 1516 PURCHASED BY A FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME STUDENT ENROLLED AT A COMMUNITY **COLLEGE ESTABLISHED UNDER TITLE 16 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, A PRIVATE** 17NONPROFIT INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION AS DEFINED IN § 10-101(K) OF 18 THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, A PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION AS 19 20DEFINED IN § 10–101(M) OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, OR A REGIONAL HIGHER EDUCATION CENTER AS DEFINED IN § 10–101(N) OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE. 21

22 (C) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY ESTABLISH FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME STUDENT 23 STATUS BY PRODUCING A VALID STUDENT IDENTIFICATION CARD AT THE TIME OF 24 PURCHASE OF THE TEXTBOOK.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
 26 1, 2018.

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
