- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a certain person from advertising, allowing to be advertised,
- 4 or calling to public attention a Schedule I controlled dangerous substance;
- 5 authorizing the Attorney General to initiate a civil action against any person who
- 6 violates this Act to recover for the State a certain penalty; providing for the
- 7 application of this Act; and generally relating to prohibiting the advertisement of
- 8 Schedule I controlled dangerous substances.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Commercial Law
- 17 **14–1326.**
- 18 (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO:
- 19 (1) A GOVERNMENTAL UNIT;
- 20 (2) A HEALTH OR MEDICAL AGENCY APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY
- 21 **OF HEALTH;**

- 1 (3) A MEDICAL, PHARMACEUTICAL, OR OTHER PROFESSIONAL 2 PUBLICATION NOT PUBLICLY DISTRIBUTED; OR
- 3 (4) A NEWS ITEM OR ARTICLE PUBLISHED IN A NEWSPAPER, 4 MAGAZINE, OR BOOK.
- 5 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT ADVERTISE, ALLOW TO BE ADVERTISED, OR CALL TO PUBLIC ATTENTION A SCHEDULE I CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE LISTED UNDER § 5–402 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE.
- 8 (C) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL MAY INITIATE A CIVIL ACTION AGAINST ANY 9 PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION TO RECOVER FOR THE STATE A PENALTY NOT 10 TO EXCEED \$500 FOR EACH VIOLATION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2018.
